- Social Responsibility: Suppliers are required to;
- Uphold Human Rights: Ensure ethical treatment of workers and adhere to fair labour practices, including the prohibition of child and forced labour, as per the laws of the land.
- Provide Safe Work Environments: Maintain a safe and healthy workplace, implementing safety standards and preventive measures.
- Support Ethical Employment Practices: Offer fair wages, respect freedom of association, and comply with laws of the land, as applicable.
- Governance and Ethical Practices: Suppliers must;
- Uphold Integrity: Conduct business with the highest ethical standards, avoiding corruption, bribery, and unethical practices.
- Foster Transparency: Maintain accurate and timely disclosures related to ESG compliance.
- Grievance Mechanisms: Establish accessible systems to address the grievances from Suppliers.

- Innovation and Partnership: Collaborate with Zydus Wellness on innovation to adopt cutting-edge sustainable technologies and practices.
- Continuous Improvement: Strive for continual improvement in environmental, social, and governance performance, working closely with Zydus Wellness.
